HONORARY RICHARD "RED" WALTER SCHOLARSHIP

BARTELME-SCHWEFEL MARINE CORPS LEAGUE SCHOLARSHIP PROCEDURES

I. INFORMATION: The MCL Detachment #349 scholarship committee administers the Richard "Red" Walter Honorary Scholarship grant. This scholarship is sponsored annually by Richard Walter's family and may be used toward a college two-year degree program at an accredited community college or college level trade school. The student should be pursuing a medical or technical degree or certification.

1. MCL Detachment #349 members may sponsor an unlimited number of applicants per year. MCL Detachment #349 members can and should self-sponsor.

Individuals are eligible to receive one scholarship per academic year with a maximum of four
(4) lifetime awards.

3. Application period extends exclusively from 1 August through 31 October. Applications and all supporting documents must be postmarked by the 31 October deadline or will not be considered. A copy of the acceptance letter or registration from the college is required.

4. A complete new package must be submitted each time applicant applies. Previous submissions will not be considered.

5. A selection board consisting of at least two (2) MCL Detachment #349 members will review all qualified applications and recommend scholarship recipients for a vote at the November MCL Detachment #349 meeting.

6. Scholarship winner(s) will be notified by official letter or email before 20 November. Confirmation of receipt is required.

7. Upon selection, the check will be mailed in November directly to the student.

II. TO QUALIFY, APPLICANT MUST SATISFY WITH PROOF ONE OF THE FOLLOWING: 1. MCL Detachment #349 member who has served, or is serving in the United States Marine Corps or Reserve; 2. Be a direct descendant by blood, legal adoption or stepchild of a MCL Detachment #349 member; 3. Be a sibling or a descendant of a sibling by blood, legal adoption, or step-child of a MCL Detachment #349 member; or 4. Be a spouse of a MCL Detachment #349 member.

III. EACH APPLICANT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR: 1. Completed legible form and all required inclusions. 2. Every applicant must have a MCL Detachment #349 member sponsor.
